VOTED NO to Mall Expansion**

**Dear SVM Petitioner**

You are receiving this email because you signed the Petition to OPPOSE the Sabri Village Market Expansion - **THANK YOU**.

The City Council Zoning & Planning Committee met this morning and after hearing Testimony, they **VOTED NO to the APPEAL** to expand the Sabri Village Market.

Here is an update from Katherine Blauvelt that attended the Meeting this morning:

*Just writing to update you that this morning the City Council Zoning and Planning Committee met and heard testimony (great job, neighbors!!) on Sabri's appeal to reverse the Planning Commission's decision to deny his Mall expansion project. The Committee voted unanimously (by voice vote) to deny Sabri's appeal. Notably, Councilmember Warsame made the motion to deny*

*the appeal, noting he has heard from many residents of all backgrounds who are concerned about the Mall, and that promises have not been kept by the mall owner.*

*So the Planning Commission's decision stands and there will be no mall expansion. Thank you for writing in to Councilmembers and sharing your views on this important issue!*

Thank you all for participating and getting involved. Obviously, our voices were heard on this issue.
