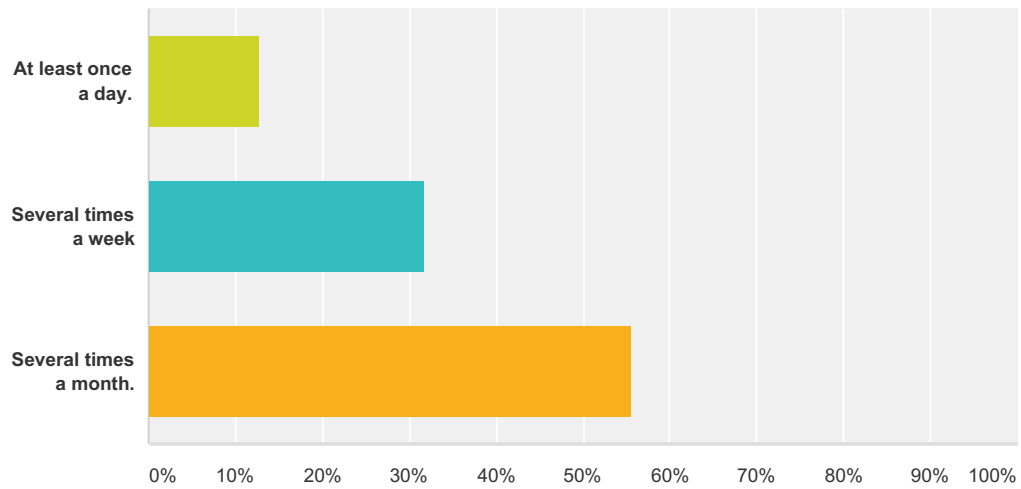


### Q1 How often do you walk across this Intersection?

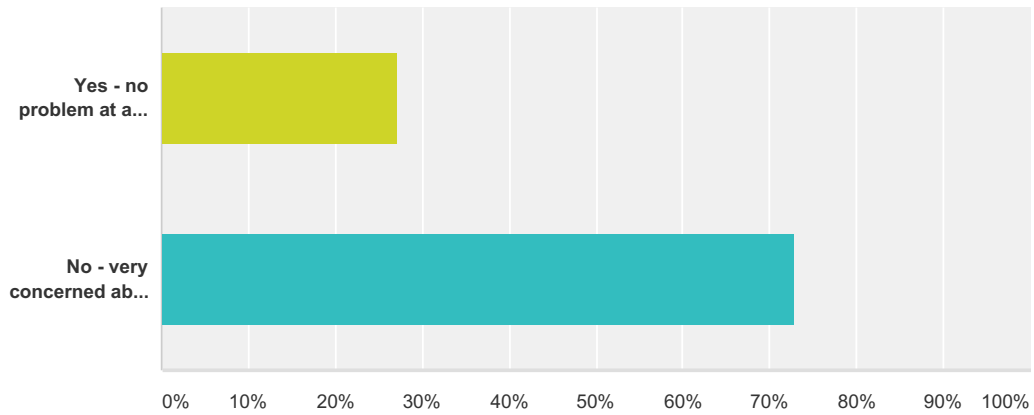
Answered: 63 Skipped: 2

### Q2 Do you feel safe crossing this intersection at East 26th Street & 11th Avenue South, by the Soccer Field?

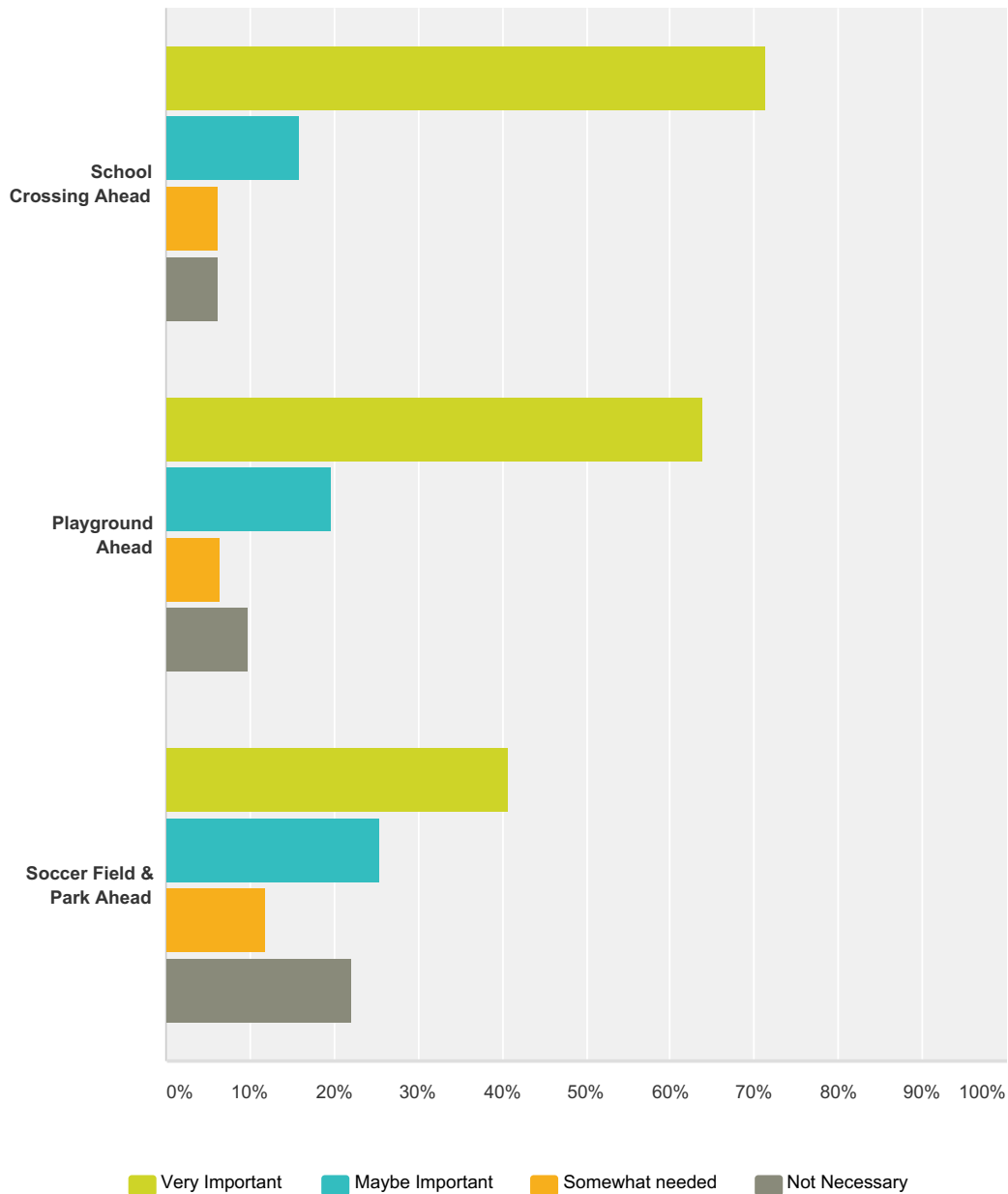
Answered: 59 Skipped: 6

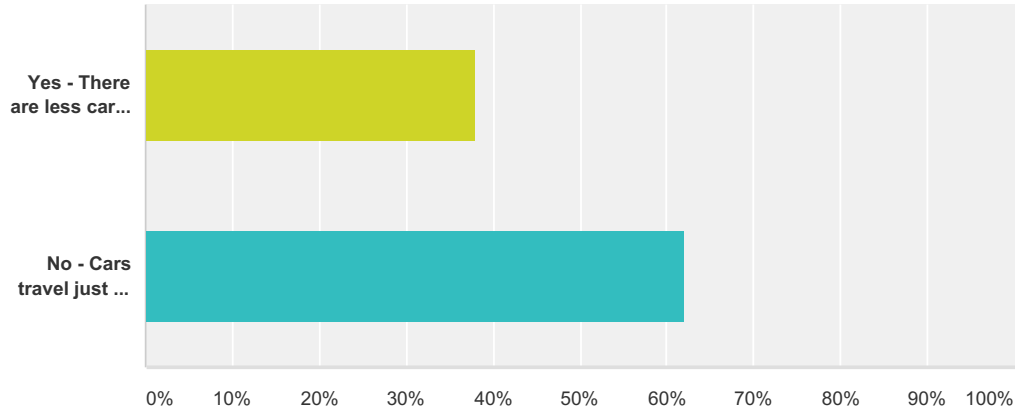

### Q4 Does the 2-Lane Traffic with a separate Bike Lane make you feel safer crossing this Intersection?

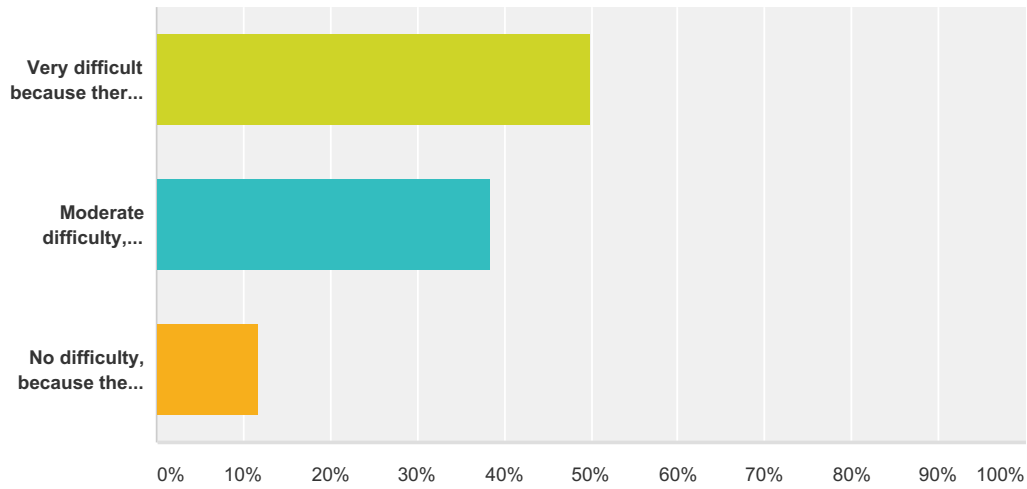

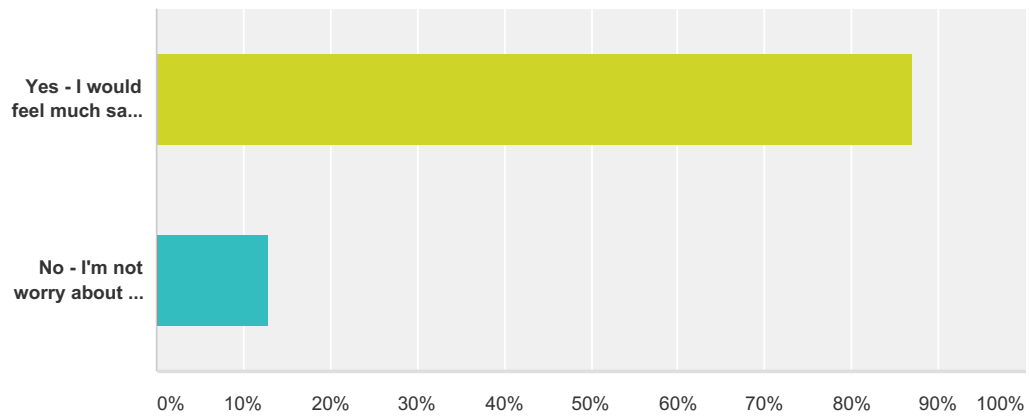
Answered: 60 Skipped: 5

### Q6 Would you like to see a Pedestrian Crosswalk at this Intersection ?

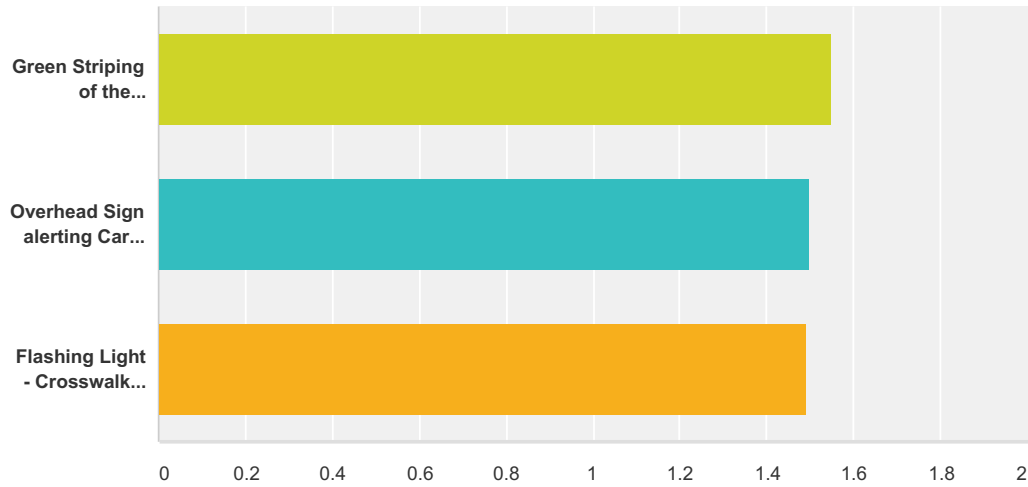
Answered: 62 Skipped: 3
